CENERAL INTRODUCTION

PROVENANCE

The material was received in June 1990 from Lady Yonge via the Natural History Museum, London.

DESCRIPTION OF THE COLLECTION

The material is presented in the order given in the tiest of Contents. There is very substantial documentation of mixty years' research by Yonge in marine belongy but regrettably virtually no personal or bioprephical material or avoords of his univarity career at Bristol and Glampow. Saterial relating to the Creat Barrier Reef Expedition which Yonge led 1938-29, and his continuing interset in the Reef thereafter, is to be found throughout the collection. Attention is drawn to Great Barrier Beef material in the following introductory paragraphs and the detailed catalogue sutries.

Section A. Diaries, presents sequences of Glasgow University pocket diaries from 1952-5) and Edinburgh University pocket diaries 1970-83. Section B, Notabooks, Occusents a number of oversees visits and copeditions. These are five notabooks relating to the Great Barrier Reef Expedition including three kept entirely or principally by Yonge's first wife who died in 1945. Other oversees visits represented include the UEA 1999 and 1956, Africa 1953 and 1962, Caroline Is. 1965 and Australia 1967.

Section C, Research, is by far the largest in the collection and documents Yonge's research on sollsecs and coral rest ecology over aix decades. There is a chrocological requesce of research folders 1922-82 whose contents may include correspondence, notes, drafts, drawings, figures, photographs and printed matter. Folders containing drawings and figures only are presented in a separate sequence arranged alphabetically by subject or folder title. There are (incomplete) lists of Yonge's scientific papers at C.535.

Section D. Societies and Organisations, documents Tonge's association with a number of British and overseas organisations. The most substantial records are of the Royal Society and in particular of a joint Royal Society/Universities of Queensland expedition to the Creat Barrier Roof in 1973. Yonge was chairman of the UK committee which oversear financial and programme arrangements. Bettom N. Correspondence, comprises general correspondence with scientific collempuse arranged chromologically and additional sequences kept together by Yonge on the Greet Barrier Reef Expedition, "Miscellaneous Boog Koog and Pacific Science" and <u>Advances in Marine</u> Biology.

Section F, Non-print material, provides important photographic records of Yonge's visits and expeditions including many not documented elsewhere in the collection. There is a comprehensive photographic record of the Great Barrier Beef Expedition including the photographs used in Yooge's 1310 book A year on the Great Barrier Beef. The section also includes maps of the Great Barrier Beef and a tape-recording 'Commentary of lower Yaland film'.

There is also an index of correspondents.

SECTION C

RESEARCH

c.1 - c.540

This section comprises very extensive documentation of sixty years' remearch in marine biology. The material was found in Yonge's often very bulky folders with ms and/or typescript titles and descriptions of contents. The bulky folders have been divided for case of reference and the titles used in the catalogue entries. The contents of Yonge's folders may include correspondence, notes on the literature, field observations, experimental data, drafts of scientific papers and lectures, drawings, figures, photographs and printed matter. As far as possible Yonge's folders are arranged in a chrosological sequence although some of the dating is necessarily tentative and folders may cover a considerable number of years. Folders containing figures and drawings only are presented in a separate sequence arranged alphabetically by subject or title. In addition to the folders Yonge used index cards for listing his acientific papers, the addresses of colleagues, biblingraphic information etc., and these conclude the section. The incomplete hibliography on index cards at C.535 was the best available at the time of cataloguing and was used in compiling the catalogue entries.
