INTRODUCTION

The papers in this collection were made available by Mrs Catherine Stoye, the daughter of Professor G P Wells FRS, in They were assembled by Professor Wells while preparing July 1991. the Royal Society memoir of Lancelot Thomas Hogben (Biographical Memoirs of Fellows of the Royal Society, 24, 1978, 183-221), and revising for publication Hogben's unpublished autobiography 'Look Back with Laughter' (which in the event remained unpublished). This collection is supplementary to the principal collection of Hogben's papers catalogued by the Contemporary Scientific Archives Centre (CSAC 78/2/81) now in the Library of the University of Birmingham. The additional material consists of Wells's correspondence with Hogben's family, friends and colleagues, his notes and drafts for the memoir, and printed and duplicated background material, and has been numbered to follow the related material in Section A of the previous catalogue. We are very grateful to Mrs Stoye for making the material available.

N.B. A reprint of Wells's Royal Society memoir is item A.1 and the drafts for 'Look Back with Laughter' items A.3-A.20 in the previous catalogue.
